

There are so many things to remember when moving.
Here's a handy checklist to help you stay on track!



Allstate Moving Checklist

One Month Before

Date: / /

- Take a full inventory of your belongings. Use **Know Your Stuff**, our online home inventory tool or download the **Allstate Household Inventory Record** (PDF format) to record your belongings. Both of these can be found online in the Relocate with Allstate section of our Customer Care Center.
 - Collect important papers (medical records, insurance policies, financial documents) and store them in a safe accessible place.
 - Make travel arrangements and hotel reservations, if necessary.
 - Use up as much food in the freezer as possible.
- Call your Allstate agent or 1-800-ALLSTATE® (1-800-255-7828) to...**
- Discuss details about your coverage when you are moving.
 - Ask if they are licensed in your new area or can assist you with locating a new agent.
 - Review insurance coverage needed at your new home.
- Contact a mover if you're not handling the move yourself. If you are moving yourself, reserve a rental truck.
 - Get boxes for packing. Check the classified section or local stores for used boxes.
 - Pick up a change-of-address kit from the post office.

Three Weeks Before

Date: / /

- Start packing! Set a goal for the number of boxes you want to pack each day. Be sure to label them by room or by items enclosed.
- Hold a garage sale to sell unwanted items. Arrange a pickup for donated items.
- Have your automobile(s) serviced.
- Submit auto registration to your new city (if required).

Two Weeks Before

Date: / /

- Send in a change-of-address notification to the post office.
- Review the Allstate **People to Contact Reminder** to notify others of your move.
- Transfer your bank accounts, if necessary.
- Make arrangements to disconnect your utilities at your current home.
- Make arrangements to connect your utilities at your new residence.
- Drain gasoline from any tools or machinery you are moving.
- Contact your realtor to confirm the seller's move-out plans and/or the buyer's move-in plans.
- Confirm any travel arrangements for pets and family.
- Transfer prescriptions from your current pharmacy to one in your new area.

One Day Before

Date: / /

- Clean the house and appliances.
- Pack personal items you'll need during the move. Consider what you'll need at your new place before the movers get there. Keep these items with you.
- If you're handling the move yourself, pick up the rental truck and moving blankets. You may want to rent a dolly to help with heavier items.

Moving Day

Date: / /

If you're working with a mover be sure to:

- Accompany the movers as they inspect and tag your possessions, making sure they correctly record the condition of each item. Be present during the loading.
- Ensure the mover has the correct address for the destination.
- Be present during the unloading. Review all delivered items at your new home before signing the necessary documents at the end of the move.
